Rules of entry

Anyone wishing to enter any of the classes should indicate that they will be submitting entries by Monday 26th June 2017 either by email to summer@scholargreen.net or on a completed entry form to the post box at the Co Op.

Entrance fees to these classes may be paid on the day of the show. N.B - this is to gauge interest in the event and the amount of space that needs to be allocated within the hall on the day.

Entry fees are 50p per item per class and entrance fees to these classes may be paid on the day of the show.

All exhibits to be staged between 10 am and 12 noon on the morning of the show, and should remain until the end of the show at 3 pm.

All exhibitors should have left the village hall by 12 noon on the day of the show so that judging can take place

The judge's decision relative to all exhibits will be final.
