Rules of entry

Entry fee to all classes is 30p per entry per class

All photographs of entries to class 1 & 2 will be displayed in the Village Hall on Show Day

All entries to classes 1 & 2 should be returned with a completed entry form and enclosed entry fee and photographs in a sealed envelope either to the marked post box inside Scholar Green McColl's or the post box at the Village Hall by Thursday 7th September

Anyone wishing to enter classes 3 to 30 (excluding Class 16) should indicate that they will be submitting entries by 7th September either by email to summer@scholargreen.net or on a completed entry form to the post box at McColl's or to the post box at the Village Hall. Entrance fees to these classes may be paid on the day of the show. N.B - this is to gauge interest in the event and the amount of space that needs to be allocated within the hall on the day.

Anyone entering class 16 should contact Andrew on andrsh712@aol.com or on 07812 717084 (after 6pm) to provide notice that they intend to enter the class by Friday 18th August so that arrangements can be made to measure the height of all entries during w/c 28th August

All exhibits to be staged between 9 am and 11 am on the morning of the show, and should remain until the end of the show at 3 pm.

All exhibits should be cleaned and trimmed as necessary before delivery to the Village Hall where they can be left displayed (produce and applicable variety clearly labelled where possible) on provided paper plates/bowls

All exhibitors should have left the village hall by 11 am on the day of the show so that judging can take place

The judge's decision relative to all exhibits will be final.
